

Early Childhood Director Search: Publicity Options

Job Boards, Online Listings and More: Where to Post Your Job Openings

The following are recommendations for recruiting an early childhood director.

It is recommended that you contact the local Board of Jewish Education, which is usually a reliable source for posting. In addition, most communities have a local Jewish paper with online classified and print advertising. Often local colleges and universities offer placement services in early childhood education. Some of the larger congregations will have success with Bank Street College, New York University, the Steinhardt School of Education and Teachers College at Columbia University.
