In conjunction with the sponsorship of HB 200, the GAWL Foundation has partnered with the Georgia Asylum and Immigration Network (GAIN). Through this partnership, the Foundation trained GAWL members to assist victims of human trafficking in obtaining visas to remain in Geor-

gia once they are released from their captors. The GAWL Foundation also awarded a grant to the Georgia Legal Services to assist them in their Teen Dating Violence Prevention Project.
